Entry Deadline: September 17th, 2023. Late entries will be charged double the fee and may not be featured in the program (excluding Class 18 (Get of Sire) and Class 19 (Produce of Dam) – entries will be taken day of event for these classes only.

You can email entries and payment to cwhba-ab@outlook.com. You will need to sign release waivers upon arrival at the show.

1. Stabling will be available on Saturday September 23rd at 4:00pm. Please do not plan your arrival before that time as the facility is closed until our office sets up.
2. The Show Office will be open from 4:00pm until 8:00pm Saturday night.
3. Stabling information will be emailed out the week before the show with information on where to go when you arrive.

In the Group Classes the entry is made under the name of the SIRE or DAM but only the offspring is shown.

Judging criterion: conformation, reproductive likeness, uniformity, quality of breed characteristics. May ask for walk and trot from each entry, optional at judges' discretion.

The Garry Bresee Memorial Trophy

The Garry Bresee Memorial Trophy will be decided by points earned by CWHBA registered horses on placings in classes and championships. We are honored to award the Garry Bresee Memorial Trophy for the high-point Canadian Warmblood Breeder from this show.

Handler's Award

The Alberta Chapter award for excellence in presentation of horses at this year's Breeder's Show aims to acknowledge the individual who demonstrates exceptional skills in presenting horses for evaluation during the event. The award will consider various factors such as the preparation of the horse, including grooming, training, and showcasing of gaits. Additionally, the recipient's personal demeanor, control, and appearance in the ring will also be considered. This award recognizes the efforts and expertise of individuals who excel in presenting horses for evaluation at the Breeders Show in Alberta.

All classes offered at this year's show will be taken into consideration when evaluating candidates for the inaugural Alberta Chapter award for excellence in presentation of horses.

CWHBA Inspection Presentation

DRESS CODE

Handlers and assistants are to wear dark green tops and black pants. Gloves are recommended. Shoes appropriate for running, preferably black. We strongly recommend wearing a helmet.

TACK

Horses to be shown in snaffle bridle with or without cavesson; regular or flash cavesson acceptable. A split or single chain may be used in addition to, or instead of reins. Bridle expected started in 2 year old classes.

BRAIDING

Horses should be braided whenever possible. It is a courtesy to the inspectors and the spectators to have the horse presented in show conditions.

SHOWING ON THE TRIANGLE

The inspection will always take place on a triangular course. Please familiarize yourself and your horse to these standards prior to the day of the event.
